HPM Legrand is recalling selected extension lead sets. These products are branded HPM.

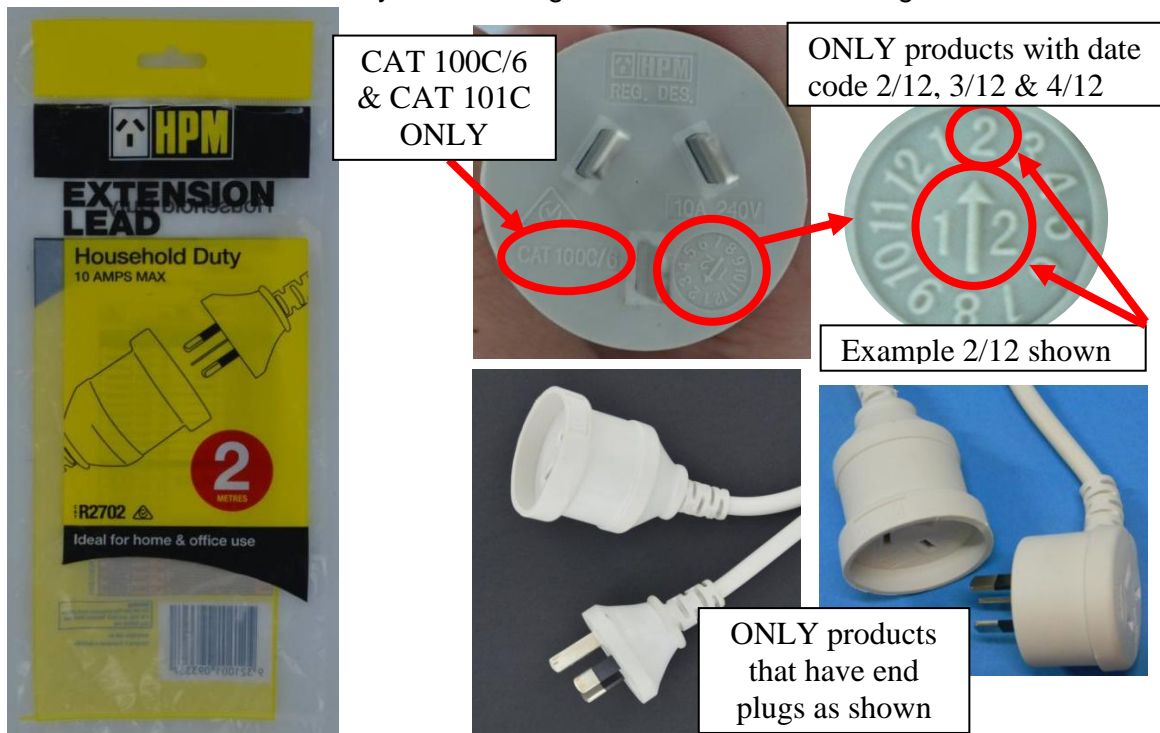
HAZARD: Risk of Electric Shock, the affected units may have transposed (swapped) wires within the cord. When in use they may apply dangerous voltages to appliances creating a shock hazard.
